Acceptance is the key to my serenity. October was a month in which many things happened around me that I had no control over — like a hurricane that hit Florida. I learned in Al-Anon to look for the positives so I could click off my gratitude list daily. Yes, there were challenges, like losing our electricity for 6 days and some minor damages outside, but I still had a roof over my head, food to eat, a generator that kept our refrigerator and TV going, temperatures that cooled off at night, and a helpful neighbor.

Before Al-Anon I would whine...Why me? Why? Why? "Why?" was my favorite question, which — of course — I never could answer. That was one of the first things — the question "Why?" — that I wrote down and put in my God Box. Today, when I live in

acceptance, I can breathe and trust that God has a plan. I found a postcard while traveling that reads BREATHE IN — BREATHE OUT, so I put that on my mirror to remind me that God is in charge, and all I have to do is breathe, right this minute.

Letting go was, and still is, difficult for me. I'm like a little child, grasping for the sweetness of life and afraid there won't be enough for me. So I hold on tightly to things and people. Again, I have to trust God that I will have everything that I need. My wants can be so distorted because of the family disease of alcoholism, that I can confuse my wants with my needs. My prayer is — God help me to want the things I have.
